## **Sustainability & Responsible Sourcing Performance Statement (BES 6001) 2025**



### **Overall Performance Rating: EXCELLENT**

At CPI Mortars Ltd, we are committed to responsible sourcing and sustainable practices across all our operations. This statement outlines our progress against the Environmental & Sustainability Standard BES 6001, demonstrating how we ensure materials are responsibly sourced throughout our supply chain.

This report covers all our production facilities throughout the UK over the period January – December 2025 and has been independently verified.

#### **GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS**

Our production facilities throughout the UK are also certified to ISO 9001 and ISO 14001.

We have also demonstrated that Quality, Environmental and Health and Safety management are established within our Integrated Management Systems and that the principles of responsible sourcing are documented throughout.

#### **SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT**

The principles of ISO 9001 are followed around the requirements for purchasing of materials, with our Ecovadis platform now being used to vet and assess both current and future potential suppliers to demonstrate ethical, social, diversity, inclusion and sustainability commitments and initiatives.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL PERFORMANCE**

CPI Mortars Ltd are part of Grafton Group plc and remain committed to reach our Science Based Targets Initiative for net zero greenhouse gas emissions across the value chain by 2050 with significant carbon reduction by 2030. In 2025, Grafton also received a Silver Sustainability Rating from Ecovadis, which is a globally recognised provider of business sustainability ratings, intelligence, and collaborative tools. The EcoVadis Silver Rating indicates that Grafton has demonstrated a strong commitment to sustainability and ranks in the top 15% of companies assessed.

In 2025, our emissions per tonne of product sold were 18.08 kg. We have achieved our year on year carbon roadmap target through continued use of HVO in our haulage fleet, fully renewable electricity which is REGO certified, solar panels which offer energy back to the grid and by starting to convert our company car fleet to electric.

## **RESOURCE USE AND PRODUCT CIRCULARITY**

The quantity of recollected mortar during 2025 remained below 1% of the total tonnage sold. This was achieved by a combination of improved communication with our customer base and a focus on improving factory production efficiencies.

For 2026, we are targeting to remain below 1% of the total tonnage sold.

## **RECYCLING**

During 2025, our general waste production was 0.23% of the total tonnage sold and 100% of this waste was recycled.

For 2026, we are targeting to reduce our general waste production by 10% and continue to recycle all our general waste.

## **WATER**

Our mains water usage during 2025 was 4.9 litres per tonne sold which was a slight increase of 4% from 2024. For 2026, we are targeting a reduction in our mains water usage of 5%.

## **TRANSPORT**

As part of our declared EPD in 2023, our constituent transport carbon impact was 6.17 kg of the total tonnage sold and our product transport carbon impact was 5.11 kg of the total. A revised EPD is being worked on ahead of the required timelines.

In line with our Net Zero goals, we have a roadmap to continue to increase the amount of HVO our haulage vehicles use throughout the UK and we continue to source our constituent materials from local businesses where practicable.

## **HUMAN RIGHTS, MODERN SLAVERY AND BUSINESS ETHICS**

Our published Modern Slavery Policy Statement is available via our website [www.cpieuromix.com/resources/](http://www.cpieuromix.com/resources/) and the business operates with a code of conduct and ethics, which identifies requirements for employees. There is also an Anti-Bribery and Corruption policy which must be signed when employment begins.

## **EMPLOYMENT AND SKILLS**

On average we conducted 8 credits of training per person during 2025. For 2026, we are committed to delivering 10 credits of training per person. We also have in place a Diversity & Inclusion Strategy as well as a highly engaged Diversity and Inclusion Employee Network.

## **LOCAL COMMUNITIES**

During 2025, there were no complaints from the local communities surrounding our sites. All production sites are classified as low risk by the local authorities.

Our commitment to community giving has increased year on year in line with our sustainability goals to give back meaningfully to our local communities. We have done so through community funding, charitable fundraising matching and volunteering colleagues time to support local initiatives.
